Join the Janney Band and have fun making music with your friends. We perform several times during the school year including the winter and spring concerts, and the Janney musical.

The Janney Band rehearses on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays at 8 a.m. in the gym. The first rehearsal will be on Tuesday, August 25 at 8 a.m.

We also offer beginning and continuing instruction on the flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, and percussion. Lesson times for beginning and continuing instruction will be set after the beginning of school to allow for the coordination of the schedules of the instructors and students (We are considering weekend lessons for those students with flexible weekends.)

We would love to have children who play other instruments to join too, provided they take private lessons on their instruments.

The band registration fee is \$400/school year which can be paid in a lump sum or in installments (In special cases, the fee may be waived by the principal.) Registration will begin immediately and extend through September 30.

If you are beginning, I would be happy to chat with you about your choice of instruments. Janney has a limited number of instruments available for rent on a first come first served basis.
