

Process for Election of Janney PTA Officers

- January/
February: Current officers decide whether they intend to re-up.
At-large members of Nominating Committee are sought from Janney community at large.
- March: General campaign to encourage the submission of candidates, using newsletter, website, posters, etc.
- March/
April: Nominating Committee develops a slate of willing candidates. If there are more individuals interested in position than there are positions (admittedly an unlikely event), there will be a competitive vote. Interested candidates are provided with a short list of questions to answer as part of the statements they will be asked to submit for publication in April.
- April: Nominating Committee publishes the slate of candidates for public review roughly three weeks before the election, together with the candidates' statements. Members of the Janney community have the opportunity to put forward additional names if they so choose up until 5 days prior to the election.
- May: PTA members vote at regular PTA membership meeting. Presidents announce results in the following week's newsletter.
- June: New Membership Committee chair submits new PTA officer roster to DC PTA by June 30th.

Process for Election of Janney SIT Officers

- April Presidents put out public call for candidates for following year's SIT, including schedule for elections and guidance on how and what should be submitted with a nomination, including biographical information and a short list of questions.
- May Two weeks prior to the Spring Picnic (which usually occurs in late May), profiles of SIT candidates are published.
- At the Spring Picnic and before and after school on the same day, parents, teachers, and students vote on SIT candidates.
- Some subset of the PTA Executive Board tabulates the results, and the Presidents post the results at school the following week.
